

# SDHS Safe Return to Schools Plan 2020-2021

## Academic Success & Accountability:

Both **attendance** and **grade requirements** must be met in order to receive credit for a course.

**Grading:** Our grading during online/distance learning will mirror the WCPS policy. Please be advised that there will be no compassionate grading this year during online/distance learning. The grading scale that we have traditionally used is in effect for all courses.

**100 - 90 = A**

**89 - 80 = B**

**79 - 70 = C**

**69 - 60 = D**

**59 - 0 = F**



**Attendance:** In order to obtain a high school diploma, students need four years of attendance at the high school level. During online/distance learning, there are two ways for students to gain attendance for EACH period during the school day.

**Synchronous:** Students log into a synchronous learning session directed by the teacher.

**Asynchronous:** Students must reply to the daily discussion question in Schoology.

*NOTE: Five or more days of unlawful absence during a marking period will result in failure of courses for that marking period.*

**Assignments:** All assignments will be graded according to the policies set forth by the teacher. Due dates and requirements with regard to make-up work will adhere to county policy of 5 days.

**Class Participation:** Synchronous Zoom participation will account for a portion of the student's grade, determined by the teacher during online/distance learning. Students/parents will need to communicate obstacles such as poor internet service or outages to the teacher in writing. Teachers will treat each situation on a case by case basis and make adjustments accordingly.
